The Community Supported Living Service offers bespoke services providing 1:1 daily and weekly visits.

All visits are person-centred as identified within the assessment and care planning process. We also offer social opportunities, such as shopping, days out, accessing healthcare services and appointments, leisure, and opportunities to meet and keep in touch with friends and family as well as support with finance and benefits.

We also offer a carers service, which offers short-term and long-term breaks for carers. We support people with severe learning disabilities and other associated conditions, such as Autism.

Capricorn Cottage comprises 28 bedrooms, including 12 en-suites rooms, for people with Learning Disabilities, located in the beautiful countryside on the outskirts of Fleet in Lincolnshire.

We strive to bring the highest standard of care to enhance the quality of people's lives. We are committed to delivering person-centred, flexible support that promotes choice, dignity, respect and control.



Respite

We offer a unique respite service within the area, as we are not a traditional respite service provider. We work with people with a wide range of needs from a variety of different backgrounds. Being responsive to finding innovative support, we provide care solutions specifically tailored to the individual.

The team are committed to working with people in a person-centred approach to enhance their quality of life while finding opportunities for people to maintain and develop new skills, based solely on how they choose to live their lives.

We are not a 'one size fits all' respite service, working proactively with people. We can adapt and change the support required at every stage of a person's stay with us.



Complex Needs Services

We can provide bespoke support for people with complex needs, learning disabilities, and those who have a range of additional needs, including mental health and behaviour that is seen as challenging.

We offer accommodation across different service types, these being 'Rose Cottage', 'The Oaks' and individual accommodation to meet people's needs.

Together we create a personalised support plan focusing on your interests and skills.



The Oaks

The Oaks is a four-bedroom supported living property offering individual tenancies.

We enable people with managing their finances, personal care needs, finding employment, educational or leisure opportunities. We aim to empower people to make informed choices, thus developing and encouraging greater independence and control.

Rose Cottage

Rose Cottage can support up to four people with complex needs. We work closely with health and social care professionals to ensure the right support at the right time to enable people to transition through the service.

To do this, we work closely with the people we support and their circles of support and professionals to ensure continuity and consistency of support.
